Club Policies

To ensure an enjoyable visit, we ask that you read and observe the Club's dress code, which will be strictly enforced.

NO DENIM: Denim of any kind or color cannot be worn anywhere on the club's premises (including shirts, dresses, vests, jackets and skirts). The club's premises includes all indoor and outdoor club facilities including the parking lot.

PARKING LOT: Changing shoes and clothing in the parking lot is prohibited. Complimentary lockers are available for guests.

MAIN DINING ROOM: No shorts, tennis attire, sweat suits, men's caps, hats or visors are permitted. No tank tops, bare midriffs, halter tops. Men are required to wear collared shirts. Cellular phones and pagers must be turned off or on vibrate.

MEMBERS' GRILL ROOM: Golf shorts (4" above the knee or longer), approved tennis and golf attire and sweat suits are permitted. Men are not permitted to wear caps, hats, or visors inside the grill room, but are acceptable on the patio. No tank tops, bare midriffs or halter tops. No tee shirts over the age of twelve. No food or drinks are permitted from outside. Cellular phones and pagers must be turned off or on vibrate.

GOLF COURSE (MEN): Tailored slacks or shorts (4" above the knee or longer). Shirts must be appropriate for golf. No tank tops or tee shirts. Hat bills must face forward. Cellular phones and pagers must be turned off or on vibrate.

GOLF COURSE (LADIES): Tailored slacks, shorts or golf skirts (4" above the knee or longer). Sleeveless tops must be collared; tops without collars must have sleeves. Cellular phones and pagers must be turned off or on vibrate.

TENNIS COURTS: Players must wear proper tennis attire and tennis shoes at all times. Men must wear collared shirts or rounded collared tennis shirts. Any other athletic attire is prohibited. Children under twelve may wear tee shirts with appropriate tennis advertising. Cellular phones and pagers must be turned off or on vibrate on courts and patio.

FITNESS CENTER: Proper fitness attire and athletic shoes must be worn at all times. No bare midriffs, swim suits, spikes, sandals, rubber suits, cut offs, outside zippers, or open toe footwear. Cellular phones and pagers must be turned off or on vibrate.

POOL: Wear cover-ups when exiting the Pool area. Sweatsuits are required in the main clubhouse. All Members and Guest must dry off when coming into the Clubhouse to any of the areas. Cellular phones and pagers must be turned off or on vibrate.
