PRNC Board Meeting

**Motion:** Motion to approve the purchase of 100 stamps for up to \$60 for use on

pre-addressed envelopes to provide to our community members to send to CARB advocating for Porter Ranch to attain a permanent, independent fenceline system under AB617 Community Self-Recommendation

procedure.

Proposed by: Susan Gorman-Chang

**Description:** AB617 is a law that provides for prioritization of communities with the

highest exposure burden of air pollutants and, for such communities, to fund and deploy air monitoring programs and community emissions reduction programs. In addition to SCAQMD making recommendations for communities to CARB under AB617, communities are allowed to make Community Self-Recommendations. While PRNC is submitting a one page document, per the procedure laid out in Process and Criteria for 2018 Community Selections, it behooves this community to also have individual community members send in personalized recommendations, since that will show community support and participation, both of which are important factors in the selection of a community by CARB. Cards & envelopes are provided at this meeting and will be provided at all PRNC

committee meetings held in the month of April.

**Benefits to PR:** Currently, there is one temporary methane monitor in the back yard of a

residence in Porter Ranch. SoCalGas's methane monitors are only

mandated for two more years under the settlement of the lawsuit between SoCalGas and the County of Los Angeles District Attorney. Thus, our community needs to work together to find funding for a permanent

fenceline system. The Ad Hoc Committee: Aliso Canyon Gas Storage Facility recommends we engage in this effort to allow us the best opportunity to be one of the communities to selected under AB-617.
