Hi, and it was nice to see you today. The problem I mentioned occurs on the eastern side of Porter Valley Dr. and Rinaldi. The problem is that cars waiting to turn left into the golf course parking block other cars that turn onto the street from being able to past on the right, therefore causing a backup onto Rinaldi. This occurs especially on the weekends when cars park on Porter Valley Dr.

If there was no parking allowed on the eastern side up past the entrance to the golf club, then traffic would be able to get by on the right and proceed up the street. I don't believe the street is wide enough to allow a left turn lane. Since it does not affect any residents it might be a simple solution to paint it red and post no parking signs.

I would appreciate your looking into this matter and letting me know what can be done.
